		 Product coverage can be found in Annex I below. The objective of the modification is to rationalize the requirements and procedures of the importation of wood products into the country. For every application for a new or renewal of a Certificate of Registration issues, the following shall be collected: (a) application/registration fee PHP 3,000.00, or (b) cash bond of PHP 12,000.00. The certificate of Registration issued shall be valid for a period not exceeding 1 year, subject to renewal for a similar period upon application and proper compliance with existing DENR rules and regulation.

44.01	Fuel wood, in logs, in billets, in twigs, in faggots or in similar forms; wood in
	chips or particles; sawdust and wood waste and scrap, whether or not
	agglomerated in logs, briquettes, pellets or similar forms.
44.02	Wood charcoal (including shell or nut charcoal), whether or not
	agglomerated.
44.03	Wood in the rough, whether or not stripped of bark or sapwood, or roughly squared.
44.04	Hoopwood; split poles; piles, pickets and stakes of wood, pointed but not sawn lengthwise; wooden sticks, roughly trimmed but not turned, bent or otherwise worked, suitable for the manufacture of walking-sticks, umbrellas, tool handles or the like; chipwood and the like.
44.05	Wood wool; wood flour.
44.06	Railway or tramway sleepers (cross-ties) of wood.
44.07	Wood sawn or chipped lengthwise, sliced or peeled, whether or not planed, sanded or end-jointed, of a thickness exceeding 6 mm.
