16	Please elaborate the changes in detail (in one of the WTO official languages)	The Hazardous Waste (Control of Import, Export or Transit) Act (HWA) provides the legislative framework for Singapore to regulate the transboundary movement control of hazardous waste and other waste controlled under the Basel Convention. Under the HWA, companies importing, exporting or transiting hazardous waste or other wastes controlled under the Basel Convention, are required to apply for a Basel Permit from NEA (Pollution Control Department, PCD). The application will require the company to submit the necessary supporting documents and obtain a Banker's Guarantee. At the 14th Meeting of Conference of the Parties to the Basel Convention (COP-14) held from 29 Apr to 10 May 2019, Parties adopted the decision to subject the transboundary movement of certain plastic wastes streams to the Prior-Informed Consent (PIC) procedure. The HWA amendment will subject these plastic waste streams for transboundary movement control under the Act. Thus, companies will be required to obtain a Basel permit for the import, export or transit of plastic wastes listed in Annex II and Annex VIII of the Basel Convention. The list of controlled plastic waste is listed as follows:
