**SUMMARY OF EXPORT RESTRICTIONS AND
TRADE EASING MEASURES RELATING TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

REPORT BY THE SECRETARIAT¹

Revision

1 INTRODUCTION

1. At its meeting of 11 October 2021, the Committee requested the Secretariat to prepare a second revision of the report summarizing the export restrictions and trade easing² measures adopted by Members in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. This report compiles and summarizes the relevant information on export prohibitions and restrictions that have been notified by Members under the 2012 Decision on Notification Procedures for Quantitative Restrictions³ (QR Decision), the communications notified by Members to the Committee with information on trade easing measures, as well as other measures by WTO Members collected as part of the WTO's Trade Monitoring Exercise and listed in the "*COVID-19: Measures affecting trade in goods*"⁴.

3. This revision takes account of all available information as of 25 March 2022. Annexes 1 and 2 provide an overview of the main elements in the export restrictions and prohibitions and the trade easing measures, respectively. In addition, the complete list of notifications and communications to the Committee that have been analysed in this report is contained in document G/MA/W/157/Rev.4.

2 EXPORT PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

4. As of 25 March 2022, a total of 98 measures that prohibit or restrict exports as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic have been adopted by Members, which have either been formally notified as a quantitative restriction or recorded by the WTO's Trade Monitoring Exercise. Of these, 68 measures have been notified by 35 Members⁵ to the Committee on Market Access under the QR Decision. According to the Trade Monitoring Exercise, 30 additional measures have been introduced by 19 Members. To the date of this report, these measures have not been notified under the QR Decision.

5. Annex 1 provides an overview of the various elements of such export prohibitions and restrictions. With a view to facilitating the analysis of these measures and to allow for their comparison, some elements were standardized (e.g. the type of measure, covered products, WTO justification, etc.). For the purpose of this report, a measure is counted individually whenever it can be clearly distinguished from another measure (e.g., if there are two clearly separate national legal instruments). Any extension, modification or termination of the original measure has not been accounted for as a new measure. QR notifications have a structured format and hence information coming from them is comparable in most cases. This is slightly less so in the case of information

from the Trade Monitoring Exercise and hence the definition of measures coming from that source might vary in terms of their scope as well as information on modifications and extensions.

2.1 Types of measures

6. The majority of the 98 export restrictive measures that have been introduced by Members in response to COVID-19 have taken the form of full bans and prohibitions (36%), followed by export restrictions in the form of non-automatic export licenses (18%) and conditional prohibitions (15%)⁶. Export restrictions mentioned in the context of the Trade Monitoring Exercise, for which there are no standardized categories of measures, account for 29% of total measures. Two measures take the form of a global quota on exports. See Chart 1.

Chart 1. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, by Type of Measure (Percentage)





2.2 Timeline of date of introduction of the measures

7. The vast majority of measures prohibiting and restricting exports have been introduced by Members between January and April 2020 (67 out of 98 measures), which coincides with the declaration of a pandemic by the World Health Organization (11 March 2020) and the consequent lockdowns and other health measures imposed by Members in response to COVID-19. It would appear that only 14 new export restricting measures were introduced since July 2020. Ten measures either do not contain information on entry into force or have several dates on when the measures began. See Chart 2.

Chart 2. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, Timeline of Date of Introduction of the Measures



2.3 Duration of measures

8. A large proportion of the export restricting measures that have been adopted by Members do not provide complete information about their duration. Of the 98 measures in the dataset, 33 have no indication of the planned duration or the concerned Member has not submitted a subsequent communication confirming that the measure had expired or had been terminated. For the 65 measures where information is available, the majority of the restrictions were in place for less than 90 days (i.e. less than three months), followed by 16 measures that were in place for between 181 and 270 days. See Chart 3.

Chart 3. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, By Duration of the Measures



2.4 Timeline of number of measures in force, by date

9. Based on the information on the date of introduction of the measures (Section 2.2) and their duration (Section 2.3), it is possible to track the number of measures that were in force for a particular date and their evolution. The available information suggests that, at the peak of the pandemic at the end of April 2020, 71 export restricting measures were in place, which was followed by a steady reduction. As of February 2022, almost two years after the peak was reached, 32 export restricting measures appear to continue to be in force. See Chart 4.


Chart 4. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, Current Status of the Measures

2.5 Covered products

10. Considering the type of products covered by the measures, a slight change throughout the pandemic can be noticed. The COVID-19 pandemic has not been cited any more as a reason for restrictions on food items in 2022 and measures on personal protective equipment and sanitizers and disinfectants seem to play a smaller role at this stage. However, some products - such as pharmaceuticals, medical devices and equipment, other medical supplies, COVID-19 test kits and vaccines - appear to be as restricted as they were during the first six months of 2020. This seems to suggest that global shortages in these products still persist.


Chart 5. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, By Covered Products

2.6 WTO justifications cited

11. For export restrictions and prohibitions that have been notified under the QR Decision, Members have provided information regarding their justification under WTO rules. The introduction of almost half of the 98 notified QR measures have been justified by Members under Article XI:2(a) and Article XX(b) of the GATT 1994, which relate respectively to export prohibitions or restrictions temporarily applied to prevent or relieve critical shortages of foodstuffs or other products essential to the exporting party, and measures necessary to protect human, plant or animal health. Members cited exclusively Article XI:2(a) of the GATT 1994 for 16% of the measures. Other policy objectives were mentioned for the remaining cases, including the protection of human life or health or the protection of essential security interests, without the reference to a specific WTO provision, or no justification at all was provided. No information in this respect is available for the 30 measures taken from the Trade Monitoring Exercise. See Chart 6.

Chart 6. Export Prohibitions or Restrictions in Response to COVID-19, By WTO Justification Cited



2.7 Current status of the measures

12. Based on information available, a slight reduction of measures in force can be seen in March 2022 when compared to the situation in October 2021 when the previous version of this report was issued. However, a third of the export prohibitions and restrictions (33%), both notified as QRs and those in the Trade Monitoring Exercise, continue to be in force by 25 March 2022. The remaining measures have either expired as initially indicated (39%) or the Member submitted a notification informing other Members that the measure had been terminated (28%). See Chart 7.

3 OVERVIEW OF COMMUNICATIONS WITH TRADE EASING MEASURES

13. Annex 2 provides a summary of the contents of all communications with trade easing measures introduced by Members in response to COVID-19 that have been submitted to the Committee on Market Access, as well as the trade easing measures collected in the context of the

Trade Monitoring Exercise. Unlike the export prohibitions and restrictions described in Section 2, which were submitted pursuant to the notification requirement under the QR Decision, these communications have been submitted voluntarily by Members for transparency purposes.


14. As of 25 March 2022, a total of 26 communications with 41 trade easing measures have been notified to the Committee on Market Access by 14 Members, which is two additional communications since the previous version of this report in October 2021. With a view to facilitating the analysis, and where the information available allows, some of the elements contained in the communications have been standardized for the purpose of comparison (e.g. the types of measures). Additional information compiled by the Secretariat in the context of the Trade Monitoring Exercise⁷ contains another 128 trade easing measures. Of these, 19 measures have been notified to other WTO committees, such as the Trade Facilitation Committee (14 measures), the Committee on Anti-Dumping Practices (two measures), the Committee on Import Licensing (one measure) and the Technical Barriers to Trade Committee (one measure).

3.1 Types of measures

15. Tax-related measures that sought to reduce the price of critical imports, thereby increasing their affordability and availability, account for slightly more than three quarters of the trade easing measures. For example, more than 50% of these measures reduced, eliminated, suspended or waived the payment of customs duties (tariffs) on the importation of products that were considered to be "essential" to combat the COVID-19 pandemic (54.6%). In addition, several Members eliminated, suspended, or waived the payment of other taxes and/or duties, such as the value added tax, on these "essential" products (14.8%). With a view to providing liquidity to importers, some Members also decided to defer the payment of tariffs and other taxes on all imported products (6% of the measures).

16. Beyond the tax-related measures, approximately 20% of the trade easing measures sought to simplify or ease customs procedures, for example through the introduction of simplified or expedited customs clearance procedures (5.5%), e.g. the establishment of green channels to prioritize the importation of critical products, and the simplification or elimination of certain procedures (14.8%). Finally, approximately 4.4% of the measures would fall under other categories, such as the establishment of special procedures for the importation of donations (relief goods) or the commitment to refrain from imposing export prohibitions or restrictions on "essential" goods. Chart 8. COVID-19 Trade Easing Measures, by types of measures





3.2 Duration of measures

17. The majority of trade easing measures seem to be temporary in nature. It should however be noted that in 82 cases the information on the intended duration of the measure is either incomplete or unavailable. For those measures where Members did provide information, the majority seem to have been in place between 180 and 365 days (i.e. between six months and one year), followed by measures that lasted up to six months and some measures with a longer duration. The measure with the shortest duration was in place for only nine days, while the one with the longest duration is expected to be in place for 987 days. It is also worth mentioning that some of the measures were described as "permanent" trade easing measures to promote trade in "essential" products to combat the COVID-19 pandemic. See Chart 9.

Chart 9. COVID-19 Trade Easing Measures, by Duration of the Measures





3.3 Covered products

18. The main categories of products covered by the trade easing measures appear to be similar in nature to those products that were subject to the export prohibitions and restrictions analysed in Section 2. Forty-seven Members adopted measures to simplify the importation of PPE, which includes the categories of face and eye protection (e.g. facemasks, face shields and protective goggles), protective garments, and gloves. They are followed by measures relating to different types of sanitizers and disinfectants, including different types of alcohol used in the preparation of these products. Interestingly, one Member used the WTO's indicative list of COVID-19 vaccine inputs⁸ to define 14 goods eligible for tariff suspension. See Chart 10.

Chart 10 COVID-19 Trade Easing Measures, by types of products (No. of Members)



3.4 Current status

19. Based on information available, 41% of the trade easing measures seem to have expired while 15% of them remain in force as of the date of this report. However, there is no information on the current status for almost 50% of the measures in the dataset. See Chart 11.
