According to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of 3 May 2022 No. 549 "On Amending Annexes 1 and 5 of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of No. 1424 of 29 December 2021" Ukraine lifted export restrictions of millet (1008 29 00 00) and sugar (1701). These goods are now subject to automatic licensing. Effective as of 10 May 2022.
