**G. Comments of a general nature, including a description of the elimination of restrictions notified under D.2.2 and the date they ceased to be in force.**

Due to Russia's ongoing military invasion of Ukraine the Government of Ukraine is forced to introduce export restriction measures on certain goods (fuel oils, coal, anthracite, natural gas) in order to ensure national economic security.

For the purpose of transparency, Ukraine notifies the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of 10 June 2022, No. 666 "On Amending Annex 1 of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 1424 of 29 December 2021".
