1 SUPPORT PROGRAMME LINE FOR MODERNISATION OF THE PROCESSING INDUSTRY

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

Support Programme line for Modernisation of the Processing Industry for 2021.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The aim of the Programme line was to strengthen the competitiveness of business entities, to improve business, productivity and profitability through investment in equipment.

The specific objectives of the Programme line were:

- Modernization of production processes,
- Efficient use of available resources,
- Diversification of the product range and improvement of product quality,
- Creating new jobs.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

Background authority for the subsidy has been the Ministry of Economic Development¹ of Montenegro in cooperation with the Investment and Development Fund of Montenegro and Commercial banks, based on the Industrial Policy of Montenegro 2019–2023, and Montenegro Economic Reform Programme 2019-2021.

5. Form of the subsidy

Grants. The amount of non-refundable support as a cover of part of the eligible costs of procurement of equipment through the loan, is in the amount of up to 35% of the net invoiced value of equipment (from EUR 7,000.00, up to EUR 70,000.00).

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

Registered micro, small and medium-sized companies and entrepreneurs who have been in the business for at least 1 year and whose registered principal activity falls within the processing industry are eligible to participate in the Programme line.

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy</u>

The available funds in 2021 for the implementation of the Programme line were EUR 1.500,000.00. In 2021 the Ministry received 29 applications from the companies operating in wood and furniture manufacturing, metal processing, processing of fruits, vegetables, milk and cheese and bread production, production of paper and cardboard products, etc. After checking the documentation, the Commission of the Ministry of Economic Development approved nine applications in accordance with the Programme line's rules. With the support of EUR 369,762.04 by the Ministry of Economic Development, the equipment worth EUR 1.071,375.00 was purchased.

2 PROGRAMME LINE OF INTRODUCTION OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

Programme line of introduction of international standards.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The Programme has aimed to provide support to entrepreneurs, small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) especially from less developed municipalities and the northern region, to increase their own size to a greater extent of competitiveness, primarily through harmonization with the requirements of international standards related to their products, management systems, staffing, testing, controlling and certification and support for obtaining accreditation for conformity assessment.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

The Ministry of Economic Development based on the Law on Regional Development of Montenegro ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 20/11), the Law on Business Companies ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro', No. 06/02), the Strategy of regional development of Montenegro 2018-2022, the Strategy for innovative activities 2016-2020, the Strategy of the development of the processing industry of Montenegro 2014-2020, Industrial policy of Montenegro until 2023. The measures contained in the Programme Line meet the criteria of Article 14 of Annex 7a - Commission Regulation (EU) No 651/2014 of 17. June 2014 declaring certain categories of assistance compatible with the internal market in application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty, the Ordinance on the list of state aid rules ("Official Gazette of Montenegro" No. 35/14, 02/15 and 38/15), so they agree with Articles 6 and 7 of the Law.

5. Form of the subsidy

The subsidy has been provided according to the principle of refund. The beneficiary of the programme financed the project, and after realization and submission of evidence of realization, the Ministry refunded the contracted amount.

Support was related to two components - for the introduction of international business standards and for obtaining accreditation for conformity assessment.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

The beneficiaries were entrepreneurs, small and medium sized companies under the criteria defined in the public call for participation. In 2021 in total 34 companies fulfilled conditions and procedures, implemented contracted activities and thus were reimbursed EUR 114,785.00 (as grants).

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy</u>

Amount budgeted for 2021 was EUR 250,000.00.

8. Duration of the subsidy

One year.

3 PROGRAMME LINE FOR SUPPORT SMALL INVESTMENTS OF ENTREPRENEURS (WOMEN AND YOUTH)

1. Title of the subsidy programme

Programme line for support small investments of entrepreneurs (women and youth), for 2021.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The Programme line for support of small investments of entrepreneurs aims to encourage entrepreneurship of women and youth as well as, to improve the efficiency and institutional support of entrepreneurs' business. This Programme Line will support vulnerable target groups by providing financial assistance, through grants to finance the procurement of fixed assets of small value.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

The Ministry of Economic Development is background authority for the subsidy. Subsidies are provided in line with the Law on Business Companies ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 06/02), the Decree on Detailed Criteria, Conditions and Manner of Granting State Aid ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 27/2010, 34/2011 and 16/14) and the Law on Accounting ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 52/16, as well as following the regulations in force in accordance with the Law on Waters ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 27/2007 and "Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 32/2011, 47/2011 - amended, 48/2015, 52 / 2016, 2/2017 - other law, 80/2017 - other law, 55/2016 - other law and 84/2018), Law on Municipal Wastewater Management "Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 002/17 from 10.01.2017) and other applicable laws that define this area.

5. Form of the subsidy

The subsidy has been provided according to the principle of refund. The beneficiary of the programme financed the project, and after realization and submission of evidence of realization, the Ministry refunded the contracted amount.

Support was intended for co-financing the costs of procurement of fixed assets - equipment and part of intangible assets - software that are directly involved in the production process/service provision:

- 1) new production equipment and/or machinery;
- 2) new computer equipment, laptops, printers, scanners and related software;

- 3) new equipment for 3D scanning, 3D printing and accompanying software;
- 4) Microsoft Office application software;
- 5) software used in CAD design (AUTOCAD, ARHICAD, CATIA, SOLIDWORKS), as well as other software used in computer-aided design;
- 6) software used in CAM/in computer-aided production;
- 7) used production equipment and/or machinery, not older than three years, which is directly in the function of creating products and/or services;
- 8) new parts, specialized machine tools.
- 6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

The beneficiaries were entrepreneurs, micro, small and medium sized companies owned by women and young people under 35 years of age (criteria defined in the public call for participation). In 2021, 189 companies applied. The number of companies fulfilled conditions and procedures, implemented contracted activities was 42 and total reimbursed amount was EUR 559,153.26 (subsidy – up to 80% of eligible costs (excl. VAT).

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount</u> budgeted for that subsidy

Amount budgeted for 2021 was EUR 650,000.00.

Intensity of support: The principle is that the entrepreneur finances 100% of all costs until the end of the activity for which he applies, and then after submitting documentation proving the expenditure of the funds of the contracted activity, the Ministry approves a refund of part of the costs in the amount of up to 50% for micro and small enterprises, the amount of eligible costs without VAT, in the minimum amount of EUR 500.00 without VAT and in the maximum amount up to EUR 47,500.00 without VAT.

8. <u>Duration of the subsidy</u>

One year.

4 PROGRAMME LINE FOR FOSTERING CIRCULAR ECONOMY

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

Programme line for Fostering Circular Economy.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. <u>Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy</u>

The Programme has aimed to provide support to entrepreneurs, micro, small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs). The Programme aimed to introduce and use modern biological processes for wastewater treatment in Montenegrin business sector. The application of Upflow Sludge Blanket Filtration (USBF) biological wastewater treatment process was in the focus of the Programme.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

The Ministry of Economic Development is background authority for the subsidy. Subsidies are provided in line with the Law on Business Companies ("Official Gazette Of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 06/02), the Decree on Detailed Criteria, Conditions and Manner of Granting State Aid ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 27/2010, 34/2011 and 16/14) and the Law on Accounting ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro" No. 52/16, as well as following the regulations in force in accordance with the Law on Waters ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 27/2007 and "Official Gazette Of Montenegro", No. 32/2011, 47/2011 - amended, 48/2015, 52 / 2016, 2/2017 - other law, 80/2017 - other law, 55/2016 - other law and 84/2018), Law on Municipal Wastewater Management "Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 002/17 from 10.01.2017) and other applicable laws that define this area.

5. <u>Form of the subsidy</u>

The subsidy has been provided according to the principle of refund. The beneficiary of the programme financed the project, and after realization and submission of evidence of realization, the Ministry refunded the contracted amount.

Support was intended to co-finance the costs of the following activities:

- Component I Wastewater treatment in agri-food industry, intended for entrepreneurs and micro-enterprises, and
- Component II Industrial wastewater treatment, intended for small and medium-sized enterprises and hotels.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

The beneficiaries were entrepreneurs, micro, small and medium sized companies under the criteria defined in the public call for participation. In 2021 only one company applied. The same company fulfilled conditions and procedures, implemented contracted activities and thus were reimbursed EUR 4,628.40 (subsidy - 70% of eligible costs (excl. VAT).

The principle is that the company finances 100% of all costs until the end of the activity for which it applies, and then after submitting documentation proving the expenditure of the funds of the contracted activity, the Ministry of Economy approves a refund of part of the costs in the amount of up to 70% for entrepreneurs, micro and small enterprises, or up to 60% for medium-sized enterprises, the amount of eligible costs without VAT, and in the maximum amount up to EUR 10,000.00 without VAT. The funds were allocated through an open grant procedure through an open Public Call, i.e. until the expenditure of available funds for the program line.

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy</u>

Amount budgeted for 2021 was EUR 200,000.00.

8. <u>Duration of the subsidy</u>

One year.

5 PROGRAMME LINE FOR THE SUPPORT OF DIGITALIZATION

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

Programme line for the support of Digitalization.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The goal of the Programme Line for the support of Digitalization was to raise the level of business automation processes and levels of knowledge of management and operational structures in MSMEs.

Specific Objectives:

- Increased number of MSMEs that have automated business processes;
- Increased exports of Montenegrin MSMEs thanks to digital business.
- 4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

The Ministry of Economic Development based on the Law on Regional Development of Montenegro ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 20/11), the Law on Business Companies ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 06/02), the Strategy of regional development of Montenegro 2014-2020, the Strategy for innovative activities 2016-2020, the Strategy of the development of the processing industry of Montenegro 2014-2020, Industrial policy of Montenegro until 2023.

5. Form of the subsidy

The principle was that the company finances 100% of all costs until the completion of the activity for which it applies, and then after the submitted documentation proving the expenditure of funds contracted activities, the Ministry approves the reimbursement of part of the costs in up to 80% of the amount of eligible costs without VAT, and in the maximum amount up to EUR 7,500.00 without VAT.

This maximum amount is if in the founding structure of the company was at least 50% female person and/or person up to 35 years of age. This aid was granted as low - value aid (de minimis aid) in accordance with EU Commission Regulation no. 1407/2013 of 18 Dec. 2013 years. The condition is that in the last six months until the day of publishing the Public Invitation, there were no changes in the ownership structure. The amount given for 2021 was EUR 95,844.42 and this amount was awarded to 16 applicants/companies.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

Entrepreneurs, small and medium-sized enterprises, have the right to participate in the programme line for support of digitalization medium - sized enterprises registered in accordance with the Companies Act ("Official Gazette RCG", No. 06/02), Decree on Detailed Criteria, Conditions and Manner of Granting State Aid ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", no. 27/2010, 34/2011 and 16/14) and the Law On Accounting (Official Gazette RCG" no. 52/16), registered in the Central Register of Business Entities.

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount</u> budgeted for that subsidy

Amount budgeted for 2021 was EUR 400,000.00.

8. <u>Duration of the subsidy</u>

One year.

6 BUSINESS ZONES

1. Title of the subsidy programme

Decree on Business zones.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The Decree defines as its aim the establishment of business zones, which are unique areas established by government or municipalities, foreseen to provide various fees reliefs to business entities within them, for the purpose of a more balanced regional development of Montenegro. Namely, Decree states that the beneficiaries of the business zones shall exercise the right to tax and other reliefs in accordance with the decisions adopted by the municipalities governing business zones.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under</u> which it is granted)

The Ministry of Economic Development is background authority for the subsidy. Subsidies are granted based on Decree on business zones, as well as Decisions on establishing business zones by municipalities which have business zones.

5. <u>Form of the subsidy</u>

The subsidies are in form of income taxes and social contributions reliefs/incentives (defined by decree) and municipal taxes and land rent reliefs (defined by municipalities).

The decree stipulates tax reliefs regarding social contributions (contributions for pension and disability insurance, health insurance, unemployment insurance and labour fund) and income taxes for business zones beneficiaries. Business zones beneficiaries can use these benefits no more than 5 years since the day of employing a person in a business zone.

During 2021, there were in total 6 approved business zones in Montenegro (in Berane, Šavnik, Bijelo Polje, Mojkovac, Nikšic and in Podgorica). There were only 5 beneficiaries of business zones reliefs in 2021, but only 2 archived reliefs from national level in total amount of EUR 738,322.50.

Decree on Business zones also allows business zones establishers to include additional benefits/incentives from local level in their respective Decisions on establishing business zones. Some of them are related to: favorable prices for land lease/purchase, exemption or reduction of utility fees, as well as fees for equipping construction land, reduction of real estate tax rate to the limit prescribed by law, exemption from personal income tax, additional infrastructural equipping of locations by the local self-government unit.

These incentives are subject to bilateral agreement between certain municipal authority and the beneficiary of the business zone.

Reliefs can amount to a maximum of 70% of eligible costs (investments in tangible assets and jobs creation) of the total investment for small enterprises, 60% for medium and 50% for large ones.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

The beneficiaries of business zones are private companies which are selected by municipalities under the criteria defined in the public call for participation.

7. Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy

There is no budgeted amount per year, as there are incentives from income taxes and social contributions, it depends on number of companies and number of employees operating in approved business zones.

8. <u>Duration of the subsidy</u>

5 years after employing a person, business zone beneficiary can use income taxes and social contributions reliefs.

7 ANNUAL PLAN OF THE INVESTMENT AND DEVELOPMENT FUND OF MONTENEGRO

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

Annual Plan of the Investment and Development Fund of Montenegro JSC for 2021.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The subsidy was provided with the goal of realization of credit lines of Investment and Development Fund of Montenegro AD, intended for:

- Development of entrepreneurship, through support for special target groups (young people, beginners, women, university graduates, technological surpluses, individual agricultural producers, innovative entrepreneurship, ICT business, cluster production, etc.);
- Growth and development of micro, small, medium and medium capitalized enterprises, with special attention to:
 - ✓ investments in priority sectors of the Montenegrin economy
 - ✓ maintaining and/or improving liquidity
 - encouraging the competitiveness of Montenegrin products/services in other markets
 - √ diversification and digitization of the Montenegrin economy
- Support for the realization of green field and brown field investments;
- Support for infrastructure projects, projects of environmental, local and state importance and projects in the field of energy and energy efficiency;
- Balanced regional development;
- Opening of new and preservation of existing jobs;

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

Investment and Development Fund of Montenegro A.D. based on the Law on Investment Development Fund of Montenegro ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No. 88/09,40/10 and 080/17) and the IDF Annual Work Plan for 2021.

5. Form of the subsidy

The aid is granted in the form of subsidized interest rates on the loans. The aid refers to the difference between the average market interest rate for placements in the economy in accordance with the statistics of the Central Bank and the current interest rate of the IDF of Montenegro per individual placement in accordance with the loan repayment period.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

Beneficiaries, based on the Plan of the Investment and Development Fund for 2021, were entrepreneurs, micro, small and medium enterprises, as well as large enterprises as defined in the programme.

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy</u>

The total equivalent of state aid for 2021 is EUR 2,315,083. The aid refers to the difference between the average market interest rate for placements in the economy in accordance with the statistics of the Central Bank and the current interest rate of the IDF of Montenegro per individual placement in accordance with the loan repayment period. In accordance with the Decision of the Council of the Agency for Protection of Competition, act no. 01-430/21-16/6 of 25 January 2021, by which the Annual Work Plan of the IDF was assessed as in accordance with the Law on State Aid Control.

8. <u>Duration of the subsidy</u>

Duration of subsidy is related to terms and conditions of specific loans.

8 ELECTRICITY PRODUCED FROM RENEWABLE RESOURCES

1. <u>Title of the subsidy programme</u>

The subsidy programme in accordance with the Energy Law for electricity produced from renewable resources.

2. Period covered by the notification

2021.

3. Policy objective and/or purpose of the subsidy

The Energy Development Strategy of Montenegro until 2030, which was adopted in 2014, has recognized the development of renewable energy sources as a strategic goal of Montenegro. The Strategy has aimed to the development of wind farms since the study of the potential of renewable sources in the territory of Montenegro had showed significant wind potential, in addition to the hydro potentials and potentials of solar energy and biomass.

4. <u>Background and authority for the subsidy (including identification of the legislation under which it is granted)</u>

The Ministry of Capital Investments took over the powers in the field of energy, previously run by the Ministry of Economy. The Ministry of Capital Investments is the background authority for the subsidy based on the following documents: the Energy Law, the Decree on acquiring the status and accomplishing entitlements of the privileged producer electricity, the Decree about compensation for encouraging electricity generation from renewable sources and high-efficient cogeneration.

5. Form of the subsidy

The aid has been granted in the form of guaranteed price, guaranteed purchase and release of balance responsibility during the duration of the privileged producer status.

6. To whom and how the subsidy is provided

Pursuant to the legal possibilities provided for in the Law on Energy and after fulfilling all prescribed conditions the companies: "Hidroenergija Montenegro" d.o.o. Berane, "Kronor" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Synergy" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Hydro Bistrica" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Igma Energy" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Krnovo Green Energy" d.o.o. Nikgić, "Nord Energy" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Simes inženjering" d.o.o, Podgorica, "Viridi Progressum" d.o.o. Kolašin, "Power AB" d.o.o. Kolašin, "BB Hydro" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Dekić" d.o.o. Podgorica, "MHE Vrbnica" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Small Hydro Power Plant Kutska" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Small Hydro Power Plant Mojanska" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Zeta energy" d.o.o. Danilovgrad, "Benegro" d.o.o. Berane, "Vodovod i kanalizacija" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Hidroenergija Andrijevica" d.o.o. Andrijevica, "Manira Hydro" d.o.o. Mojkovac, "Možura Wind Park" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Eco solar system" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Invicta" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Alliance" d.o.o. Podgorica, "Fudbalski savez Crne Gore" d.o.o. Podgorica and "Bar-kod" d.o.o. Podgorica have gained the Status of a privileged producer for 12 years. In accordance with the Status of a privileged producer they have been entitled to use the aid.

After acquiring the status of a privileged producer, the companies have signed the Electricity Purchase Agreement with the Montenegrin Electricity Market Operator, guarantying purchase at a defined price for 12 years.

7. <u>Subsidy per unit, or in cases where this is not possible, the total amount of the annual amount budgeted for that subsidy</u>

Montenegro has determined the selling price of electricity produced in plants during the entire period of the purchase contract.
