NOTIFICATION OF LAWS, REGULATIONS AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES RELATING TO SAFEGUARD MEASURES

BELIZE

The following communication, dated 5 March 2014, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Belize.

This is to notify that Belize has no laws, regulation and administrative procedures relating to safeguard measures within the meaning of Article 12.6 of the Agreement on Safeguards and thus has not, to date, taken any investigation of serious injury. Belize shall promptly notify the Committee on Safeguards ("the Committee") of any changes that may take place in this regard. Specifically, Belize shall notify the Committee pursuant to Article 12.6 of the Agreement upon the establishment of any laws and regulations, and shall report without delay to the Committee any investigation in accordance with Article 12 of the Agreement.
