The following communication, dated 26 March 2021 and received on 29 March 2021, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of India.

India hereby submits its notification concerning non-imposition of a safeguard measure on "Single Mode Optical Fibre".

1. Precise description of the product involved

The product concerned is 'Single Mode Optical Fibre' which refers to the Optical Fibre used to facilitate transmission of a single spatial mode of light as a carrier and is used for signal transmission within certain bands.

2. Reference of WTO documents notified earlier

The initiation of the investigation was notified vide WTO document G/SG/N/6/IND/46 and the provisional findings vide WTO document G/SG/N/8/IND/32 – G/SG/N/10/IND/23 – G/SG/N/11/IND/18. No provisional measures were imposed. The final findings were notified vide WTO document G/SG/N/8/IND/32/Suppl.1 – G/SG/N/10/IND/23/Suppl.1 – G/SG/N/11/IND/18/Suppl.1.

3. Reason why the measure ceased to apply

The Central Government examined the recommendation of the Designated Authority (DGTR) and decided not to impose the safeguard measure.
