## COMMUNICATION FROM MEXICO

The following communication, dated 6 April 2016, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of  $\underline{\text{Mexico}}$ .

- 1. Pursuant to Article 7 of the Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures and paragraph 3(b) of Annex B thereto, Mexico hereby advises WTO Members that a notice announcing the introduction of new guides and rules under Official Mexican Standard NOM-001-SAG/FITO-2013, establishing the criteria, procedures and specifications for the development of variety guides and rules for determining the quality of seeds for sowing, has been published on the website of the National Seed Inspection and Certification Service.
