**PHYTOSANITARY CERTIFICATE FOR EXPORT, PHYTOSANITARY  
CERTIFICATE FOR RE-EXPORT AND ATTACHMENTS**

COMMUNICATION FROM NICARAGUA

The following communication, dated 31 January 2018, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Nicaragua.

1. The Institute for Agricultural and Livestock Protection and Health (IPSA), established by Law No. 862 creating the Institute for Agricultural and Livestock Protection and Health, published in Official Journal *La Gaceta* No. 91 of 20 May 2014, hereby advises that it will be issuing phytosanitary certificates for re-export and export and re-export certificate attachments, if necessary, in line with the recommendations set forth in International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) No. 12.

2. Phytosanitary certificates for re-export and relevant attachments will enter into force on 15 February 2018.
