1 THEMATIC SPS WORKSHOP

- 1. The Secretariat will organize a special SPS thematic workshop to focus on maximum residue levels (MRLs), to be held in Geneva, Switzerland. The workshop will take place on Monday, 24 October and Tuesday, 25 October 2016. The SPS informal and regular meetings will be held on 26-27 October 2016.
- 2. The objective of the workshop is to bring together officials responsible for participation in and implementation of the SPS Agreement, as well as the relevant international standard-setting organization and scientific bodies for an in depth discussion, at a technical level, on maximum residue levels. More specifically:
 - a. Participants will review the SPS Agreement and MRLs, including the relevant provisions of the Agreement and jurisprudence;
 - b. Participants will review the Codex approach to establishing MRLs. This will include relevant information on the respective work of Codex and scientific bodies, such as the Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues (CCPR), the Joint FAO/WHO Meeting on Pesticide Residue (JMPR), the Codex Committee on Residues of Veterinary Drugs in Foods (CCRVDF), and the Joint FAO/WHO Expert Committee on Food Additives (JECFA);
 - c. Participants will be exposed to the relevant international, regional and bilateral work being undertaken on pesticide residues; and
 - d. Participants will discuss their experiences in complying with MRLs and establishing MRLs, including information on their domestic regulatory and legal infrastructures.
- 3. The workshop is open to participation by all delegates from WTO Members and Observers attending the SPS Committee meeting in October 2016.
- 4. The WTO, with the financial assistance of the Doha Development Agenda Global Trust Fund (DDAGTF), will sponsor the participation of at least 25 government officials from developing country Members and Observers. The Secretariat will select participants to be sponsored from applications received from capital-based officials holding direct responsibilities in the SPS area.
- 5. Preference will be given to applications from least-developed countries (LDCs), and from developing country Members and Observers that have not been sponsored to participate in a thematic workshop on the SPS Agreement in the recent past. No more than **one** participant from each country will be selected.

- 7. An economy-class round-trip air-ticket (excursion fare, if applicable), accommodation, daily subsistence allowance, **at least** for the <u>duration of the workshop (24-25 October 2016)</u>, and terminal expenses will be provided to the selected participants as of the opening day of the activity. Detailed administrative arrangements shall be communicated directly to the selected participants in advance of the workshop.
