<b>6. Description of content:</b> This Order of the Minister of Agriculture, Rural Development and Water Management provides some protective measures against the outbreak of bluetongue disease in point 4. Stopping the import of all ruminants and herbivores as well as, semen, embryos and ova of all ruminants and herbivores affected by the bluetongue disease, from the territories described in point 4, to the Albanian territory. The veterinary certificate should guarantee their origin. The measures also consist in stopping the import of unsterile biological materials originating from all ruminants and herbivores affected by the bluetongue disease in the territories described in point 4, to the Albanian territory.
