Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Regarding immediate notification of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in Canada on 30 November 2014, and in compliance with Article 10.4.4, Chapter 10.4 of the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code, Canada is no longer identified as a country free from Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza.
