- 5. Title of the notified document: United Arab Emirates is imposing a temporary ban on the importation of domestic and wild birds and their untreated by-product, day-old chicks, hatching eggs, poultry meat and table eggs from England in the United Kingdom. Language(s): Arabic. Number of pages: 2
- 6. **Description of content:** Following the notification published by the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) on 19 December 2016 regarding the outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza virus (HPAI) in England in the United Kingdom, United Arab Emirates is applying a precautionary sanitary measure to prevent the risk of introducing HPAI virus through the imports of live birds and their products from England. These measures include:
 - Temporary ban on the importation of domestic and wild birds and their untreated by-products, day-old chicks and hatching eggs, poultry meat and table eggs and their untreated products originating from England in the United Kingdom, except heat-treated products;
 - 2. Consignments of poultry meat shipped from England in the United Kingdom before 20 November 2016 were permitted.
- 7. Objective and rationale: [X] food safety, [X] animal health, [] plant protection, [X] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- 8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: There is a risk of contamination from importing poultry and poultry products from England in the United Kingdom, which is affected with Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza. This follows the notification of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in England in the United Kingdom on 19 December 2016. These applied measures are in compliance with Article 10.4.4, Chapter 10.4 of the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code.
