Description of content: This is to inform that the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply (MAPA) issued Normative Instruction No. 14, from 16 June 2015, to establish the phytosanitary import requirements for fresh fruits harvested in 2014/2015 season of apples (<i>Malus domestica</i>), pears (<i>Pyrus communis</i>) and quinces (<i>Cydonia oblonga</i>) from Argentina. It revokes Normative Instruction No. 18 of 19 April 2011 notified in the document G/SPS/N/BRA/77/Add.6 of 3 May 2011.
