Addendum

The following communication, received on 10 February 2017, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Fenpyroximate

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for fenpyroximate notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1076 (dated 14 November 2016) was adopted 7 February 2017. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

<u>MRL (ppm)</u>	<u>Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u>
44	Tea (dried leaves)
10	Citrus oil; hops (dried)
7.0	Peppermint tops; spearmint tops
2.0	Stone fruits (crop group 12-09)
1.0	Small fruits vine climbing, except kiwifruit (crop subgroup 13-07F); low growing berries (crop subgroup 13-07G)
0.50	Citrus fruits (crop group 10R)
0.40	Edible podded snap beans
0.30	Pome fruits (crop group 11-09)
0.15	Avocados; black sapotes ; canistels; mamey sapotes; mangos; papayas; sapodillas; star apple
0.10	Tuberous and corm vegetables (crop subgroup 1C); melon (crop subgroup 9A); tree nuts (crop group 14); pistachios; undelinted cottonseeds
0.05	Field corn flour; refined corn oil
0.02	Field corn; popcorn grain

MRLs are established for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (<http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/cps-spc/pest/part/protect-proteger/food-nourriture/rccg-gcpcr-eng.php>) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of Health Canada's website.
