#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 15 March 2017, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

### Established Maximum Residue Limit: Myclobutanil

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for myclobutanil notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1089 (dated 15 December 2016) was adopted 12 March 2017. The proposed MRLs are established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

## MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

O.1 Grain lupin, dry kidney beans, dry lima beans, dry navy beans, dry pink beans, dry pinto beans, dry tepary beans, dry beans, dry adzuki beans, dry blackeyed peas, dry catjang seeds, dry cowpea seeds, dry moth beans, dry mung beans, dry rice beans, dry southern peas, dry urd beans, dry broad beans, dry guar seed, dry lablab beans
