#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 16 June 2017, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

#### Established Maximum Residue Limit: Fluoxastrobin

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for fluoxastrobin notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1101 (dated 21 March 2017) was adopted 12 June 2017. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

MRL (ppm)	Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity
1.5	Melon (Crop Subgroup 9A)
0.5	Squash/Cucumber (Crop Subgroup 9B)
0.06	Peanut Oil (refined)
0.02	Peanuts
ppm = parts per million
