## Addendum

The following communication, received on 10 May 2019, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Penthiopyrad

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for penthiopyrad notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1238 (dated 13 February 2019) was adopted 8 May 2019. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

<u>MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup></u> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

10 Caneberries (crop subgroup 13-07A)

6.0<sup>2</sup> Bushberries (crop subgroup 13-07B)

<sup>1</sup> ppm = parts per million

<sup>2</sup> Lowbush blueberries and lingonberries belong to Bushberries (crop subgroup 13-07B). The MRL of 6.0 ppm replaces the currently established MRLs of 3.0 ppm for lowbush blueberries and lingonberries, and establishes new MRLs for the remaining food commodities in the crop subgroup.

MRLs are established for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (<u>https://www.canada.ca/en/health-canada/services/consumer-product-safety/pesticides-pest-management/public/protecting-your-health-environment/pesticides-food/residue-chemistry-crop-groups.html</u>) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of Health Canada's website.
