Addendum

The following communication, received on 14 January 2020, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Ethylene Oxide

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for ethylene oxide and ethylene chlorohydrin notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1277 (dated 4 October 2019) was adopted 10 January 2020. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

Ethylene Oxide:

<u>MRL (ppm)</u> ¹	Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity
7	Dried vegetables, sesame seeds

Ethylene Chlorohydrin:

<u>MRL (ppm)</u> ¹	Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity
940	Dried vegetables, sesame seeds

¹ppm = parts per million
