Addendum

The following communication, received on 21 April 2020, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Tetraniliprole

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for tetraniliprole notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1297 (dated 24 January 2020) was adopted 19 April 2020. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:
