#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 19 April 2024, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

#### Established Maximum Residue Limits: Tolpyralate

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for tolpyralate notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1543 (dated 23 January 2024) was adopted 17 April 2024. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

0.01 Barley, wheat
