Addendum

The following communication, received on 14 January 2014, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Established Maximum Residue Limits: Spirotetramat

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for spirotetramat notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/744 (dated 21 October 2013) was adopted 7 January 2014. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

<u>MRL (ppm)</u>	<u>Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u>
9.0	Taro Leaves
4.0	Bananas, plantains
3.0	Bushberry Subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07B)
2.5	Fruiting Vegetables (Crop Group 8-09)
2.0	Watercress
1.5	Globe Artichokes, sweet corn kernels plus cobs with husks removed
0.8	Bulb Vegetables (Crop Group 3-07)
0.7	Pome Fruit (Crop Group 11-09)
0.6	Citrus Fruit (Revised Crop Group 10)
0.5	Instant Coffee, pomegranates
0.3	Low Growing Berry, except Strawberry Subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07H), except lowbush blueberries and lingonberries; pineapples
0.2	Green Coffee Beans
0.08	Meat by-products of cattle, goats, horses and sheep
