The following communication, received on 18 June 2014, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Amitraz

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for Amitraz notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/777 (dated 16 December 2013) was adopted 16 June 2014. The proposed MRL, established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database, is provided directly below and is legally in effect as of the publication date in the MRL Database.
