- **6. Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2014-02 is to consult on the listed domestic maximum residue limits (MRLs) for fludioxonil that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).
  - MRL (ppm) Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity
  - 6.0 Tuberous and corm vegetables (Crop Subgroup 1C, except true yam tubers)<sup>a</sup>

a This action revises the established Canadian MRL of 0.02~ppm for potatoes and of 3.5~for Tuberous and corm vegetables except potato (Crop Subgroup 1D), except true yam tubers for which an MRL of 8.0~ppm is currently established.
