- 5. **Title of the notified document:** Proposed Maximum Residue Limit: Cyprodinil (PMRL2014-28) **Language(s):** English and French **Number of pages:** 7
- 6. **Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2014-28 is to consult on the listed domestic maximum residue limits (MRLs) for cyprodinil in plant commodities and for cyprodinil, including the metabolite CGA-304075 in animal commodities that have been proposed by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).

## MRL (ppm) Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

- 1.7 Crop Group 11-09 (Pome fruits)<sup>a</sup>
- 0.02 Fat, meat and meat by-products of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep; milk

ppm = parts per million

<sup>a</sup> This action revises the established Canadian MRL of 0.1 ppm for Pome fruit to accommodate a reduction in the preharvest interval and adds MRLs for the remaining commodities in the revised Crop Group 11-09.
