Description of content: The objective of the notified document PMRL2014-72 is to consult on the listed domestic maximum residue limits (MRLs) for fludioxonil that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA). <u>MRL (ppm)</u> <u>Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u> 7.0 Caneberry subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07A) ^a 3.0 Low growing berry subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07G) ^b 2.0 Bushberry subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07B) ^c , Small fruit vine climbing, except fuzzy kiwifruit subgroup (Crop Subgroup 13-07F) ^c ppm = parts per million ^a This MRL is proposed to replace the established MRL of 4.2 ppm for residues of fludioxonil in/on blackberries, raspberries and loganberries ^b This MRL is proposed to replace the established MRL of 2.0 ppm for residues of fludioxonil in/on strawberries ^c The established MRL of 2.0 ppm for residues of fludioxonil in/on blueberries will be extended to all crops in Crop Subgroup 13-07B and the established MRL of 2.0 ppm for residues of fludioxonil in/on grapes will be extended to all crops in Crop Subgroup 13-07F MRLs are proposed for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the Residue Chemistry Crop Groups webpage (http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/cps-spc/pest/part/protect-proteger/food-nourriture/rccg-gcpcr-eng.php) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of Health Canada's website.
