Consequently, the phytosanitary requirements governing the importation into Chile of plants, cuttings and twigs of the species <i>Prunus dulcis</i> , <i>P. mahaleb</i> , <i>P. cerasus</i> , <i>P. avium</i> , <i>P. domestica</i> , <i>P. salicina</i> , <i>P. cerasifera</i> , <i>P. armeniaca</i> , <i>P. persica</i> and <i>P. persica</i> var. <i>nucipersica</i> from the United States of America, must be updated.
