If no, describe, whenever possible, how and why it deviates from the international standard: The different indexes of this standard are as follows: In this standard, the loss on drying (crystals) $\leq 11.5\%$, sulfates (as SO₄) $\leq 0.04\%$, the heavy metals (as Pb) ≤ 10 mg/kg and the arsenic (As) ≤ 2 mg/kg, the limit for lead is not required. The standard is consistent with the actual condition of Chinese products.
