Description of content: This standard applies to the food additive Quinoline Yellow using 2-(2-quinolyl)-1,3-indandione or a mixture containing about two-thirds 2-(2-quinolyl)-1,3-indandione and one-third 2-[2-(6-methyl-quinolyl)]1,3-indandione as raw materials, produced through sulfuration. It specifies the technical requirements and test methods for food additive Quinoline Yellow.

The indexes of Type II product are different from the international standard: organic compounds other than colouring matters ≤ 0.5%, subsidiary colouring matters ≤ 4.0 mg/kg, the arsenic (As) ≤ 1 mg/kg, the zinc

	(Zn) \leq 50 mg/kg, the limit for ether-extractable matter is not required. The standard is consistent with the actual condition of Chinese products.
