It specifies the technical requirements and test methods for food additive Quinoline Yellow. 7. The indexes of Type II product are different from the international standard: organic compounds other than colouring matters ≤ 0.5%, subsidiary colouring matters  $\leq$  4.0 mg/kg, the arsenic (As)  $\leq$  1 mg/kg, the zinc

 $(Zn) \leq 50$  mg/kg, the limit for ether-extractable matter is not required. The standard is consistent with the actual condition of Chinese products. 9.
