- **Description of content:** The Ministerial Decree mandates that the producers and importers must comply with the Egyptian Standard ES 7985/2013 "Edible Vegetable oils". Producers and importers are given a transitional period of six months to abide by the standard. This standard supersedes the following Egyptian Standards (ES no.):
