Addendum

The following communication, received on 18 September 2015, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Japan.

Additional animal health requirements for live swine animals to be exported to Japan from countries where Porcine epidemic diarrhoea (PED) is endemic notified in document G/SPS/N/JPN/358 dated 28 July 2014

This addendum is issued to add the Netherlands to specific regions or countries in Item 4 of the notification G/SPS/N/JPN/358 dated 28 July 2014 because outbreaks of PED were confirmed in November 2014 and January 2015.

Consequently, the requirements for PED in Item 6 of the notification are applied to live swine animals to be exported from the Netherlands.

The requirements for the Netherlands came into force on 15 September 2015.
