6.	Description of content: The notified standard establishes the technical guidelines and procedures for authorizing Maximum Residue Levels for chemical pesticides for agricultural use. It is binding throughout Mexican territory and applies to natural or legal persons wishing to register chemical pesticides for agricultural use in Mexico, which, pursuant to the applicable legal provisions, require a Maximum Residue Level. The following will be exempted from complying with this standard: Pesticides for use with ornamental plants, tobacco and soil exclusively for pre-sowing application; those to be applied in empty storage areas, trucks and containers; and those the exemption of which is justified under applicable legal provisions.
