Description of content: An Act to strengthen the food regulatory system in the country to protect consumer health and facilitate market access of local foods and food products, and for other purposes. The new law lays down a comprehensive framework that sets the benchmark for food safety in various stages from the harvest to the manufacture, processing, handling, packaging, distribution, marketing, food preparation to its consumption.
