- **Description of content:** The Philippines is imposing temporary ban on the importation of poultry and poultry products originating from Ilinsky, Dolgovo, Novochikhinsky and Altayskiy Kray, Russian Federation.

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: A reported outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) serotype H5N1 was detected affecting domestic chickens, geese, and ducks in Ilinsky, Dolgovo, Novochikhinsky and Altayskiy Kray, Russian Federation last 30 September 2014. The Philippines is instituting this emergency measure to prevent the entry of the HPAI virus to protect the health of the local poultry population.
