- **6. Description of content:** This order provides the rationale and the conditions in instituting this emergency measure imposing a temporary ban on the importation of poultry and poultry products from England.

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: This MO was issued based on the official report submitted by Dr Nigel Gibbens, Chief Veterinary Officer, Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, London, United Kingdom to the World Health Organization for Animal Health (OIE) on 2 February 2017, confirming that there were seven outbreaks of H5N8 Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus in three provinces from 11 December 2016 to 29 January 2017 affecting turkeys, pheasants, game birds, chickens, and ducks as confirmed by the National Animal and Health Agency (APHA), Weybridge (OIE Reference Laboratory).
