- **Description of content:** This order provides the rationale and the conditions in instituting this emergency measure imposing a temporary ban on the importation of poultry and poultry products from Moscow Oblast, Rostov Oblast and Republic of Tatarstan, Russian Federation.

Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: This MO was issued based on the official report submitted by Dr Evgeny Nepoklonov, Vice-Minister, Ministry of Agriculture, Moscow, Russia to the World Health Organization for Animal Health (OIE), that there were fifteen outbreaks of H5N8 Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus in three federal subjects affecting birds from 26 Febraury 2017 to 3 May 2017 as confirmed by All-Russian Research Institute for National Animal Health (National Laboratory).
