- **6. Description of content:** This letter introduces a temporary restriction due to the outbreak of the African swine fever virus (ASF) in February 2014 on the territory of Poland. This measure applies on import of:
 - live pigs and its genetic material;
 - pork products (which were not heat treated no less than 80°C for at least 30 minutes);
 - products from slaughter of wild boars;
 - horn-hoofed and leather, intestinal materials;
 - bristles;
 - feed for pigs;
 - hunting trophies, which were not subjected to full taxidermy treatment;
 - previously used equipment for maintenance, transportation, slaughter and cutting of pigs.
- 7. Objective and rationale: [X] food safety, [X] animal health, [] plant protection, [] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- **8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action:** This measure is to avoid the introduction of the ASF virus into the territory of the Russian Federation.
