Description of content: This document establishes deadlines and a sequence of administrative procedures (actions) by the Federal Service for Veterinary and Phytosanitary Supervision and its territorial offices, as well as by customs services exercising veterinary state supervision at the state border of the Russian Federation. The proposed Regulation sets procedures for cooperation between units and officials of the above mentioned authorities, cooperation with legal and natural persons, other governmental authorities and institutions of local government, establishments and organizations in the import, export and transit of controlled goods.
