These requirements will be applied for import of laboratory animals (mice, rats, guinea-pigs, rabbits), its embryos, birds' embryos, sperm and cell culture.
	This document also introduces amendments to the Chapter 35 of the mentioned Requirements. This Chapter is amended by norms for feed and feed additives tests for presence of botulinum toxin.
