6.	<b>Description of content:</b> Following the OIE report, Ref. No. 11, Vol. 28 (16524) dated 11 March 2015, which indicates that Epizootic Ulcerative Syndrome outbreak in North West of South Africa. It is deemed necessary for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to prevent the entry of Epizootic Ulcerative Syndrome into the country. Therefore, the import of live Catfish from South Africa to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is temporarily suspended.		
7.	Objective and rationale: [ ] food safety, [X] animal health, [ ] plant protection, [X] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [ ] protect territory from other damage from pests.		
8.	Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Previous outbreak of Epizootic Ulcerative Syndrome (1 February 2013) was reported by official announcement of the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE). Its reoccurrence on 2 August 2014 in South Africa urges the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to institute this emergency measure to prevent the entry of Epizootic Ulcerative Syndrome into the country.
