6.	<b>Description of content:</b> According to the official announcement of the International Epizootic Bureau as of 17 February 2014 is registered the disease of African swine fever (ASF) in the territory of Poland.		
	In order to avoid entering the disease into the territory of Ukraine, the decision of the Inspector of Veterinary Medicine of Ukraine as of 18 February 2014 temporarily prohibits import from the Republic of Poland of live animals, animal products susceptible to detected disease such as raw and reproductive material from them.
