Corrigendum

The following communication by the United States is being circulated.

The Food and Drug Administration is correcting a direct final rule that appeared in the Federal Register of 11 May, 1998. The document lifted the stay of the effective date for the allowable levels of the bottled water quality standard for nine chemical contaminants, i.e., antimony, beryllium, cyanide, nickel, thallium, diquat, endothall, glyphosate and dioxin, that was imposed in a final rule published on 26 March 1996. The document was published with some errors under the "Date" section. This document corrects those errors.

DATES: The regulation published at 63 FR 25764 is effective 2 February 1999. Submit written comments by 27 July 1998. If no timely significant adverse comments are received, the agency will publish a document in the Federal Register no later than 6 August 1998, confirming the effective date of the direct final rule. If timely significant adverse comments are received, the agency will publish a document of significant adverse comment in the Federal Register withdrawing this direct final rule no later than 6 August 1998.
