3.1.2 US imports of meat from Brazil - Concerns of Nicaragua

3.6. El Salvador outlined that FMD was an exotic illness and joint efforts of countries were necessary to maintain Central America's FMD-free status without vaccination. It supported Nicaragua's concerns as the country depended mainly on exports of agricultural goods and a possible outbreak of FMD could bring about significant economic consequences. Guatemala also supported the concern since imports of agriculture products of cattle origin from FMD-free countries with vaccination could put the country at great risk.
