NOTIFICATION

Addendum

The following communication, dated 23 May 2015, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of <u>Brazil</u>.

This addendum aims to inform that the National Institute of Metrology, Quality and Technology – INMETRO, issued Ordinance N° 241, 18 May 2015, prohibiting the manufacture, importation and/or marketing, of baby feeding bottles and baby feeding bottles nipples customized, throughout the national territory and order their immediate seizure.

Furthermore, the Ordinance N° 241/2015, emphasized the maintenance under the Brazilian System of Conformity Assessment – SBAC, of a compulsory certification for baby feeding bottles and baby feeding bottles nipples which shall be carry out by a third part product Certification Body – OCP, established in Brazil and accredited by Inmetro, previously set by the Ordinance N° 490/2014 and Ordinance N° 34/2009.

Comments must be postmarked no later than 19 June 2015.
