ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable): All food from animal clones; this would include: meat and edible meat offal, dairy produce; birds' eggs; natural honey; edible products of animal origin, not elsewhere specified or included, products of animal origin, not elsewhere specified or included (if food or used for food production), animal or vegetable fats and oils and their cleavage products; prepared edible fats; animal or vegetable waxes (if food or used for food production), preparations of meat, of fish or of crustaceans, molluscs or other aquatic invertebrates (if food or used for food production), miscellaneous edible preparations (if obtained from animal clones if food or used for food production)
5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Proposal for a Council Directive on the placing on the market of food from clones (COM(2013) 893 final) (11 pages, in English).
6. Description of content: This proposal would provisionally prohibit the marketing of food from animal clones. The rules would only concern the clones themselves (not offspring or descendants). The proposed Directive would require Member States to report to the Commission on the operation of the Directive 5 years after its transposition. The Commission would then present a report on the application of the Directive to the Parliament and Council taking into account the national reports, scientific and technical progress particularly that relating to animal welfare aspects of cloning and international developments. Member States would be required to transpose the Directive into national law within one year after its entry into force.
