## NOTIFICATION

### *Addendum*

The following communication, dated 8 February 2017, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Indonesia.

---

Regulation of Minister of Trade No. 67/M-DAG/PER/11/2013 concerning Affixed Mandatory Label in Indonesian Language for Goods is revoked and replaced by Regulation of Minister of Trade No. 73/M-DAG/PER/9/2015.

The amendment covers, *inter alia*:

- Certificate of Inclusion Label in Bahasa Indonesia Language (SKPBLI) is not a mandatory procedure since exporter can ship the goods to Indonesia without any Bahasa Indonesia Label. After the shipment has arrived, it should be labelled in Bahasa Indonesia before entering the market;
- Additional HS products should be affixed with Bahasa Language listed in Annexes of this regulation.
