- 5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Jamaican Standard Specification for CODEX general standard for food additives (CODEX STAN 192-1995) (271 pages, in English).
- 6. Description of content: This document specifies the conditions under which food additives may be used in all foods and provides a list of food additives which are recognized as suitable for use in foods. It applies to all foodstuffs, including those in which no food additives are permitted.
- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Establishing maximum use levels for food additives in various food groups is to ensure that the intake of an additive from all its uses does not exceed its Acceptable Daily Intake (ADI) thereby providing consumers with safe, quality food for consumption.
- 8. Relevant documents: A notice of the *Jamaican Standard Specification for codex general standard for food additives (CODEX STAN 192-1995)* will appear in The Jamaica Gazette Supplement Proclamations, Rules and Regulations. When adopted, the document will appear as a Jamaican Standard Specification, with mandatory status, and will be available for sale.
