- 6. **Description of content:** This Kuwaiti /Gulf draft technical regulation concerns the following types of soft candy: toffee, turkish delight, nougats, fondant, marshmallow, fudge, fruit pastes which has not been issued by an independent specification (excluding chewing gum, chocolate types and western and oriental sweets). Items related to requirements, packaging transportation & storage and labelling (items 4, 7 and 8) are compulsory. The remaining items are voluntary.
